Section 5 – First Aid

- Eye : Immediately flush eye with plenty of cool running water. Remove contact lenses. Continue flushing for at least 15 minutes, holding eyelids apart to ensure rinsing of the entire eye. Consult a Physician.
- Skin : Immediately flush skin with plenty of cool running water for at least 15 minutes. Remove contaminated clothing and shoes. Wash clothing before reuse.
- If Swallowed : Rinse mouth at once, then drink one or two large glasses of water or milk. Do not induce vomiting. NEVER give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
- If Inhaled : Immediately move to fresh air.
